

Webelos Adventure camp June 12th through the 15th.

Additional Adult leaders Cost is 50 Dollars(Bring with you to camp). All adult leaders need to bring a completed health form with them as well. The pack has covered the cost of the registered adult leaders.

Our check in time is 1:30 pm Sunday June 12th.

We will meet at 11:00am at Calvary Methodist Church to load up and car pool to the camp.

Cubs are asked to wear their swimming trunks to the camp (swimming tests are done at check in). Cubs also need to have their full uniforms (uniforms are worn to dinner).

I have attached a health form and an equipment check list. I have turned in all the health forms for camp. But in case they have lost one I would fill this out the health form and check off each item on the list and bring this flyer with you to camp.

Located between Anderson and Elwood. From Indianapolis, take I-69 to State Road 37 north to Madison County Road 500 N. Turn east 2 miles to camp gateway on your right. [OR from State Road 9 to Madison County Road 500 N. Turn west 8 miles to camp gateway on your left.] Camp is approximately 30 minutes from Castleton. There is a highway sign on S.R. 37 with the camp name on it.

Equipment Check List

- Complete Webelos uniform (shirt, shorts/trousers, neckerchief & slide, belt, Webelos hat) or appropriate leader's uniform for evening meals, campfires, and flag lowering.
- Clothes (shorts, 1 pair of jeans, t-shirts, pajamas or sleeping clothes), underwear, and socks for at least four days.
- Extra socks.
- Jacket, sweater or sweatshirt.
- Swimsuit (**worn to camp**). One-piece swimsuit for females.
- Towel (Packed easy to reach for swim checks the first day)
- Athletic shoes or comfortable hiking boots, and one pair of

- shoes that can get wet and be worn in the water for canoeing.
- Lots of extra socks! At least two extra pair
- Plastic bags for wet clothing to travel home.
- Poncho or raincoat.
- Backpack or duffel bag that can be easily carried to campsite.
- Canteen or water bottle.
- Sleeping bag or blankets and sheet, and a small pillow.
- Toilet kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, comb, etc.).
- Notebook, pencil, pen and Webelos Handbook.
- Suntan lotion and non-aerosol insect repellent (with DEET).
- Flashlight with extra bulbs and batteries.
- Watch, first aid kit, camera & film, sewing kit, religious materials.
- \$30 spending money for souvenirs & snacks at the Trading Post
- Work gloves for 2nd year Webelos.
- Prescription medication **in its original container.**
- Order of the Arrow sash and firecrafter shirt (den chiefs)
- ***What NOT to bring***
